
Volunteer Spotlight - Tony Viglietti

Tony is a longtime JAST member and member of the Nashville Cherry Blossom Festival Planning Committee. Every year, he works diligently months ahead of the Festival, braving cold and wet weather to inspect and repair electrical outlets and power boxes at Public Square. On the day of the Festival, Tony provides electrical and technical services to our exhibitors and vendors.

Tony serves as Beautification and Environment Commissioner for District 7 and volunteer Executive Director of Friends of Riverside Drive, which he founded to restore Riverside Drive to its beautiful original condition and as a memorial to American servicemen and women. Tony initiated the planting of hundreds of Yoshino cherry trees on Riverside Drive.
